

BEEF RULES

Heifers:

1. All exhibitors must comply with the general rules and regulations of the Kiwanis Ogeechee Fair.
2. All commercial and registered breeding heifers must be completely transferred to exhibitor by August 1, 2026.
3. All heifers must be born on September 1, 2024 or after.
4. All beef cattle must have tattoo for identification purposes with the exception of branding as specified by specific breed organizations.
5. Each exhibitor will be allowed to enter a maximum of 3 heifers.
6. The heifer must possess the ability to consistently be handled and under control while wearing halter. Should any heifer display disruptive behavior, the judge or show officials reserve the right to remove the animal from the show ring.
7. Exhibitors can show a heifer or steer in showmanship.
8. Showmanship classes will be Cloverleaf (Grade 4-5); Junior (Grade 6-8) and Senior (9-12).
9. All REGISTERED heifers must be born after September 1, 2024.
 - a. Classes will be broken by age and breed
 - b. There must be five (5) entries checked in to constitute a breed. If there are less than 5, they will show after other breeds.
10. AGE CLASSIFICATIONS:
 - a. Junior Heifer Calf: Born January 1, 2026 and after
 - b. Winter Heifer Calf: Born November 1 to December 31, 2025
 - c. Senior Heifer Calf: Born September 1 to October 31, 2025
 - d. Late Summer Heifer Calf: Born July 1 to August 31, 2025
 - e. Summer Heifer: Born April 1 to June 30, 2025
 - f. Junior Yearling: Born January 1 to March 31, 2025
 - g. Senior Yearling: Born September 1 to December 31, 2024
11. Commercial heifers must be born after September 1, 2024
12. Commercial heifers will be weighed by show officials. Weights will be recorded and commercial heifers will show by those weights.
13. Premiums for heifer classes will be:
 - a. 1st- \$35
 - b. 2nd- \$32
 - c. 3rd- \$29
 - d. 4th- \$ 26
 - e. 5th- \$23
 - f. 6th and below: \$20

Grand Champion Heifers: \$75

Reserve Champion Heifers: \$50

There will be a Grand and Reserve champion selected for each breed.

14. Check in for all cattle will be from 8:00am to 11:00am on Saturday, October 24th, 2026.

STEER RULES:

1. All exhibitors must comply with the general rules and regulations of the Kiwanis Ogeechee Fair.
2. All steers must be in possession of the exhibitor by August 1, 2026.
3. Steers must be born after August 1, 2025
4. Steers must have tattoo for identification purposes with the exception of branding as specified by specific breed organizations.
5. Each exhibitor will be allowed to enter a maximum of 3 steers.
6. The steer must possess the ability to consistently be handled and under control while wearing halter. Should any steer display disruptive behavior, the judge or show officials reserve the right to remove the animal from the show ring.
7. Steers will be weight at check in by show officials. Weights will be recorded and steers will show by those weights.
8. Exhibitors can show a heifer or steer in showmanship.
9. Showmanship classes will be Cloverleaf (Grade 4-5); Junior (Grade 6-8) and Senior (9-12).
10. Premiums for steer classes will be:
 - a. 1st- \$35
 - b. 2nd- \$32
 - c. 3rd- \$29
 - d. 4th- \$ 26
 - e. 5th- \$23
 - f. 6th and below: \$20

Grand Champion Steer: \$75

Reserve Champion Steer: \$50

11. Entry fee is \$15 per animal and includes showmanship.
