

BREEDING GILT RULES

1. All exhibitors must comply with the general rules and regulations of the Kiwanis Ogeechee Fair.
2. All gilts should be transferred to the exhibitor by August 1, 2026.
3. Each exhibitor will be allowed to enter a maximum of 3 breeding gilts.
4. IDENTIFICATION:
 - a. All REGISTERED gilts (Berkshire, Duroc, Hampshire, All Other Breeds (AOB), Spot and Yorkshire) must have a ear notch that corresponds to the registration paper. A State of Georgia ear tag is not required.
 - b. All COMMERCIAL gilts must have ear notch AND official State of Georgia ear tag with only one (1) official tag per hog.
 - c. Ear tag, ear notch and registration number (if applicable) must match what is on the entry form. Tag number cannot be used as ear notch and vice versa.
5. CONTROL: all swine must possess the ability to be always under control by the exhibitor. Should any swine display disruptive behavior, the judge or show officials reserve the right to remove any animal from the show ring.
6. GROOMING: water and oils without dyes will be the only substances permitted for coat dressing. No adhesives allowed.
7. Entries that are BRUISED, CUT LATE, UNSOUND or LAME, NOT OF SHOW CALIBER, SHOW SIGNS OF STRESS OR NOT MATCHING ENTRY FORM will be disqualified. Those animals will not be allowed to show in showmanship.
8. Showmanship classes will be divided into the following: Pre Club (3rd grade and below); Cloverleaf (Grade 4-5); Junior (Grade 6-8) and Senior (Grade 9-12).
9. All Breeding gilts must be farrowed between February 1 and April 30, 2026.
 - a. Classes will be broken by breed and age.
 - b. There must be five (5) entries checked in to constitute a breed. If there are less than 5 entries, gilts will show in other breeds.
 - c. The breed classifications will be: DUROC, HAMPSHIRE, ALL OTHER BREEDS, YORKSHIRE. If there are enough animals entered for a breed not listed, it will be added.
 - d. AGE CLASSIFICATIONS:
 - i. All gilts farrowed between February 1- February 28, 2026
 - ii. All gilts farrowed between March 1- March 31, 2026
 - iii. All gilts farrowed between April 1-April 30, 2026.
10. COMMERCIAL GILTS
 - a. Gilts will be weighed by show officials. Weights will be recorded and will show by those weights.
 - b. Weight requirements for commercial gilts will be a minimum weight of 225 and a maximum weight of 375.

11. Premiums for all breeding gilt classes will be as followed:

- a. 1st - \$30
- b. 2nd - \$27
- c. 3rd - \$ 24
- d. 4th - \$21
- e. 5th - \$18
- f. 6th & below: \$15

Grand Champion Gilt: \$75

Reserve Champion Gilt: \$50

There will be a grand and reserve champion selected for each breed.

12. Check In for all swine will be from 12:00pm to 3:00pm on Tuesday, October 20, 2026.

13. Entry fee is \$15 per animal and includes showmanship.

MARKET HOG RULES

1. All exhibitors must comply with the general rules and regulations of the Kiwanis Ogeechee Fair.
2. All market hogs should be transferred to the exhibitor by August 1, 2026.
3. All market swine must be born after January 1, 2026.
4. Each exhibitor will be allowed to enter a maximum of 3 market hogs.
5. IDENTIFICATION:
 - a. All REGISTERED market barrows(Berkshire, Duroc, AOB, Spot, Yorkshire) must have an official State of Georgia ear tag, ear notch and registration number. All CROSSBRED barrows and market gilts must have ear notch and official State of Georgia ear tag with one (1) tag per hog.
6. CONTROL: all swine must possess the ability to be always under control by the exhibitor. Should any swine display disruptive behavior, the judge or show officials reserve the right to remove any animal from the show ring.
7. GROOMING: water and oils without dyes will be the only substances permitted for coat dressing. No adhesives allowed.
8. Entries that are BRUISED, CUT LATE, UNSOUND or LAME, NOT OF SHOW CALIBER, SHOW SIGNS OF STRESS OR NOT MATCHING ENTRY FORM will be disqualified. Those animals will not be allowed to show in showmanship.
9. Showmanship classes will be divided into the following: Pre Club (3rd grade and below); Cloverleaf (Grade 4-5); Junior (Grade 6-8) and Senior (Grade 9-12)
10. All market swine will be weighed by show officials. Weights will be recorded and will show by those weights.
 - a. Market swine must weigh between 215 and 290 pounds.
11. Premiums for all market swine classes will be as followed:
 - a. 1st - \$30
 - b. 2nd - \$27
 - c. 3rd - \$ 24
 - d. 4th - \$21
 - e. 5th - \$ 18
 - f. 6th & below: \$15

Grand Champion Market Hog: \$75

Reserve Champion Market Hog: \$50

17. Entry fee is \$15 per animal and includes showmanship.
